### 1 SELECT *D.C. DRIVE*

*For California Homeowners July 1st, 2019* • A new law will require all new automatic garage doors sold in California after July 1st to include a battery backup. That means even if only the door is being replaced, the operator/opener must be replaced as well if it does not comply to the new regulations.

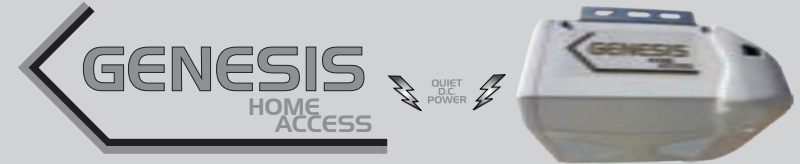
### 2 CHOOSE *CHAIN, BELT OR JACKSHAFT*

All D.C. drive units are quiet. Choose based on your budget or special requirement. Chain drives are a little less money but still quiet. Belt drives cost a little more but are more quiet. Jackshaft units are a space saving, very unique and very quiet option that cost a little more than chain or belt drives. Your dealer can help you decide which model would fit you best.

### 3 PURCHASE *FROM A DEALER*

Buy your D.C drive new garage door opener from a professional door dealer. They have better, stronger models than the stores. They sell stronger one piece rail units, not 3-5 piece units like in the big box home centers/hardware/dept stores. Plus, units are full chain or full belt professional models, not 1/2 chain, 1/2 cable or 1/2 belt models. Professional models sold only through dealers are better and stronger than store purchased models.

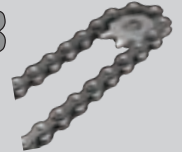
